Career Tech Ed with LEED Gold certification Buchanan Energy Academy at Buchanan High School

The “Energy Academy,” currently in construction, will be part of the District’s vibrant ‘Career Tech Ed’ program and was made possible through CTE grants. The building will be LEED ‘Gold Certified’ and serve as a model for teaching green technology. It will incorporate various solar and wind power technologies, radiant flooring and walls built of insulated concrete forms (ICF).
